We have an artisan village of 15 vendors who pay for tables and they bring in there products to sell, we will have bake goodies and basket raffle. We have 5 or 6 baskets already, and can make another 5 to 15. All vendors bring something to put in a basket. We currently have 2500 items so we need to know how many people will be shopping so we have enough items for the kids. Flyer will be online and going home. Christmas city will be there to take pictures on stage with sleigh.

Spirit wear – sold a lot in September we place an order at the end of each month, we order from place in Emmaus. It will be delivered soon. Waiting for coffee mugs and bags

Vice Pres report – went to first faculty meeting to introduce myself and tell them that I will relate any items from PTO to faculty.

Bingo – Raffle basket items are not coming in. we might get 15 baskets, but we are used to getting 30 to 40. Just want people to be aware that there will be less baskets. Everything else is good to go. Tickets will start coming home next week.

There is roller skating, laser tag, min golf, rock climbing wall and more outdoor activities if it is in the spring. Deal would be Friday March 2, 5 – 9 or 6 – 9. 5-9 \$15 charges \$3 to willow. 6-9 \$12 with \$2 goes back to Willow. We can sell at school, we could take a dollar off, or they can just sell all tickets there, so we wont have to worry about selling. Can we change the date??? If it is in spring then more activities outside?
